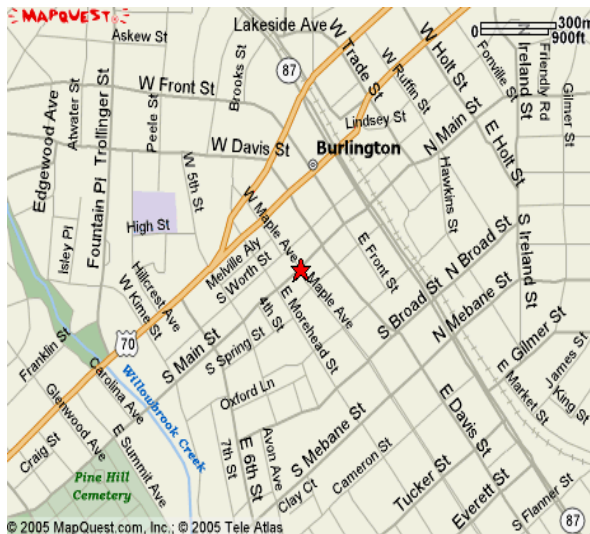


Where?

Alamance Hotel was designed by noted architect Charles Conrad Hartmann.*

The Hotel was built in 1926 and served for decades as the city's leading hotel and center of social and civic activity.

Alamance Hotel was completely rehabilitated and renovated in 1983 and has been certified as a historic site and listed in the National Register of Historic Places.

Plus . . .

Among Alamance Hotel's features are an elegant entrance way and lobby, an electronically controlled building entry system, carpeted hallways, on-premise commercial laundry, apartment level recreation areas, two elevators, fire alarms, smoke detectors, hallway sprinkler system, satellite TV, landscaped walkway access, on-premise offices and a number of especially designed units for handicapped and disabled persons. Other amenities include a resident computer room, Internet access, fax, copier as well as an exercise room with exercise bicycle and treadmill.

An onsite Services Coordinator is here to help residents identify and locate community services based on their needs such as food assistance, home healthcare, and prescription discount assistance.
